- acquisition and development of new technologies and methods.



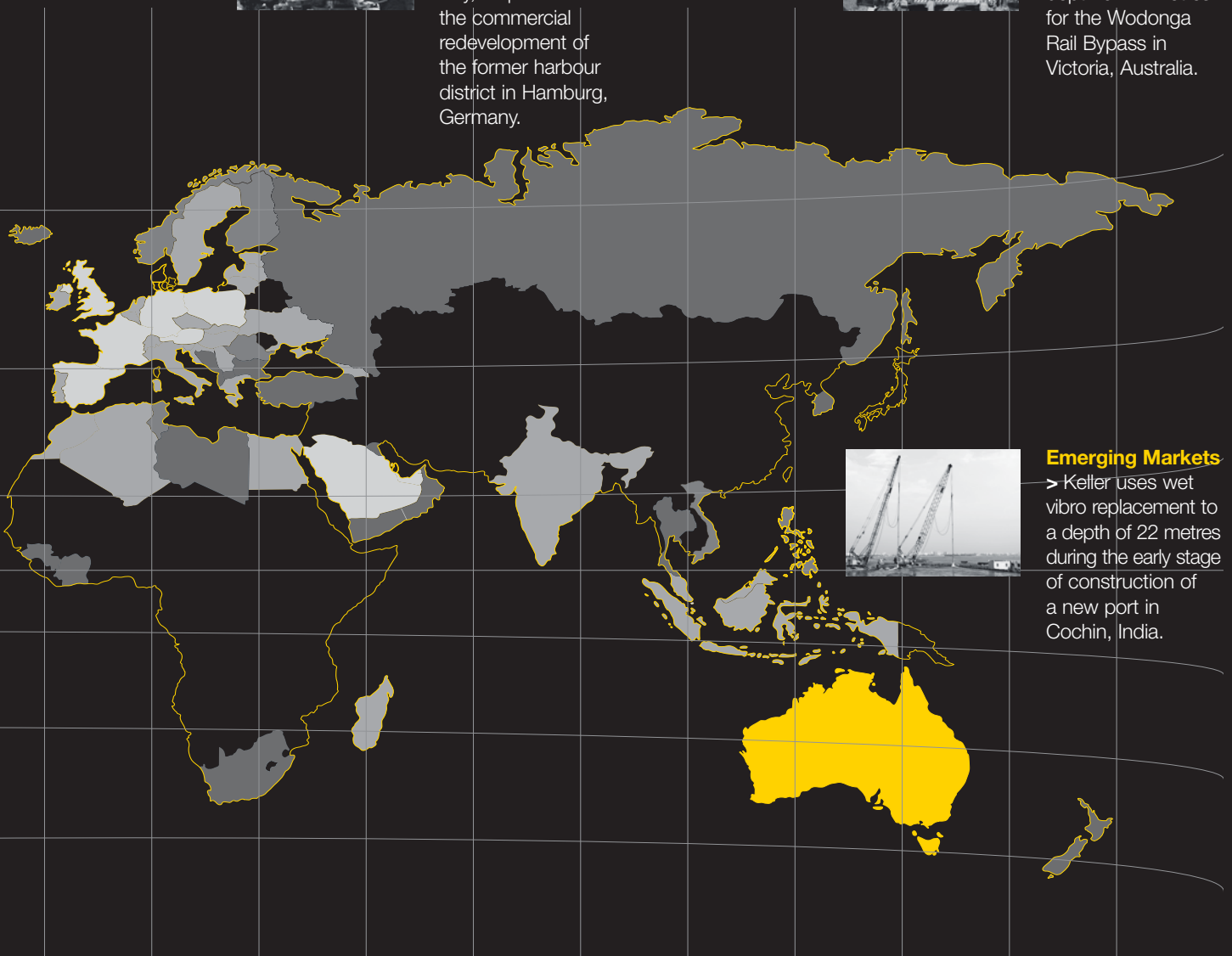
**CEMEA**
